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Baxa to Sponsor Exhibitor's Theatre: *The Pros and Cons of Standardized Parenteral Nutrition* at ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting in Las Vegas

Active in numerous scientific and professional societies, Dr. Sacks is a member of the American Society for Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (ASPEN) and has held offices in both its national and state organizations. The program builds on Sacks' knowledge of regulatory and clinical requirements for safe PN systems, providing recommendations for the components of a standardized process and guidance on the roles and responsibilities of pharmacists in promoting best practice.

The complimentary, one-hour educational program will be held Monday, December 3rd in Palazzo Ballroom C, of the Sands Expo Center, beginning at 11:15 AM. Participants are eligible for one credit hour of Pharmacy Continuing Education (CEU).
